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## Recipes:

### Recipe 1 – Mug Cake

#### Ingredients -

- 4 tbsp of self raising flour.
- 4 tbsp of caster sugar
- 2 tbsp of coco power
- 1 egg
- 3 tbsp of milk
- 3 tbsp of vegetable or sunflower oil
- 2 tbsp of chocolate chips (optional)
- Vanilla essence (optional)

#### Method -

- Step 1: Add the flour, caster sugar and coco powder to the **largest** mug you have and mix.
- Step 2: Add the egg and mix as much as you can. (Don't worry if there is still dry mix left.)
- Step 3: Add the milk, oil and a few drops of vanilla essence and mix until smooth. (If using chocolate chips then add at this stage)
- Step 4: Place your mug in the middle of the microwave and cook for 1 and a half to 2 minutes.
- Step 5: Enjoy!

### Recipe 2 – Chocolate Easter Nests

#### Ingredients -

- 225g of chocolate (choice on which to use is down to you)
- 50g of butter
- 75g of cornflakes
- A bag of Mini Eggs

#### Method -

- Step 1: Place 12 cupcake cases in a cupcake tin
- Step 2: Melt the chocolate and butter in a bowl over a saucepan of water until smooth.
- Step 3: Remove the bowl from the heat and gently stir in the cornflakes until all the cereal is coated in chocolate.
- Step 4: Divide the mixture between the cases and then place 3 chocolate eggs on top of the nests. Chill in the fridge for one hour or until completely set.

### Recipe 3 – Eggy Bread

#### Ingredients -

- 2 medium eggs
- 1 tbsp milk
- 2 slices white bread or brown bread
- 1 tbsp butter

#### Method -

- Mix both eggs and the milk together in a bowl.
  - Preheat your pan with the butter.
  - Dip your slice of bread into your egg mix and place in the pan.
  - Fry on both sides until golden brown.
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## Activities:

### Activity – Egg Painting

Equipment -

- Hard-boiled egg (one or more), paint or colored pens, paintbrush (if using paint), paper, saucepan.

Safety -

- Young People may need adult supervision during this activity.

Method -

- Step 1 – Design: Decide on your designs to decorate your egg/eggs. Maybe you could practice the design by drawing it on a piece of paper.
- Step 2 – Prep: Boil your eggs and leave to cool. This will then become your canvas for painting on.
- Step 3 – Make: Draw or paint your designs onto your eggs. Try not to make a mess!
- Step 4 – Finish: Leave your masterpieces to dry. Then take a photo of them and send it into us through social media or the email address provided.

### Activity – Escape room

- Pen
- Paper
- A device to complete the escape room.
